

## **SOUTH MOLINE TOWNSHIP ANNUAL TOWN MEETING**

### **Minutes**

Clerk Loken convened the meeting at 6:01 p.m. He confirmed ten people in attendance. Present: Elvia Aguilar, Goyo Aguilar, Steve Glenn, Greg Aguilar, Craig Loken, Luis Moreno, Maritia Griffin, Jeff Rivera, Joe Lambrecht, and Asha Pangrazio. All stood and said the Pledge of Allegiance.

Loken asked for a nomination for moderator and pay them a sum of \$50.00. There was a motion by Asha Pangrazio to nominate Craig Loken, the motion was seconded by Aguilar. All ayes, motion carried.

Clerk Loken administered the oath of office to Pangrazio.

Pangrazio stated that upon entering the meeting, all were given these documents: a copy of the Proposed Agenda, a copy of the Supervisor's Financial Report, Copy of the Road Commissioner's Financial Report, copies of proposed resolutions, and a copy of the minutes from the 2025 Annual Town Meeting.

Pangrazio asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the 2025 Town Meeting. Maritia Griffith to approve the 2025 minutes. The motion was seconded by Joe Lambrecht. All ayes, motion carried.

Pangrazio asked for departmental reports.

Supervisor- Aguilar thanked the trustees for great first year, went through a few highlights of the impact made in the first year. Township continues to maintain a healthy balance sheet and budget.

Road & Bridge Commissioner gave updates on needed upgrades to maintain safe work conditions.

Pangrazio read a resolution for next year's Town Meeting to be held on Tuesday, April 13th, 2027 at 6:01 p.m. The meeting will be held at the South Moline Township Senior Center. There was a motion by Moreno to approve. The motion was seconded by Rivera. All ayes, motion carried.

Pangrazio read aloud the resolution presented in order for the town to be able to transfer \$150,000 to the Road and Bridge Fund from the General Township Fund, if needed. Griffith made a motion to approve the resolution. The motion was seconded by Rivera. All ayes, motion carried.

Pangrazio asked if there was any public comment. Steve Glenn gave thanks to the township board for the work done in year one. He was shocked to the state neglect some of the township buildings were in and supportive of the work planned. He commented on his visit to the Road & Bridge facility and shocked at the condition.

Pangrazio asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. There was a motion by Lambrecht that we adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Rivera. All ayes, meeting adjourned 6:16pm
